**ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS  
STIPULATED BY THE LOAN AGREEMENT (SPECIAL OPERATIONS) WOMEN'S  
ENTREPRENEURSHIP SUPPORT SECTOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM SIGNED  
BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND ASIAN DEVELOPMENT BANK ON 25  
JANUARY 2013 WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

Proceeding from the results of consideration of the case and ruled by Article 100(2), Article 102, Parts 1 and 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the RA Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:
