## ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT FOR THE ENCOURAGEMENT AND RECIPROCAL PROTECTION OF INVESTMENTS SIGNED ON 7 NOVEMBER 2012 BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF IRAQ IN BAGHDAD WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Proceeding from the results of Case consideration and governed by Article 100, Point 2, Article 102, Parts 1 and 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63 and 64 of the RA Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

1. The obligations stipulated by the Agreement for the Encouragement and Reciprocal Protection of Investments signed on 7 November 2012 between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Republic of Iraq in Baghdad, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.

2. Pursuant to Article 102, Part 2 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
