DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

THE CASE CONCERNING OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT ON ENSURING COORDINATED INTERACTION AMONG COMPETENT AUTHORITIES OF THE CIS MEMBER STATES IN THE FIELD OF STRUGGLE AGAINST INTERNATIONAL TERRORISM AND OTHER FORMS OF EXTREMISM SIGNED ON 5 DECEMBER 2012 IN ASHGABAT WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Proceeding from the results of consideration of the case and being ruled by Article 100(2), Parts 1 and 4, Article 102, of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the RA Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated by the Agreement on Ensuring coordinated interaction among competent authorities of the CIS Member States in the field of struggle against international terrorism and other forms of extremism signed on 5 December 2012 in Ashgabat, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Article 102, Part 2 of the RA Constitution this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
