ON THE CASE CONCERNING DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE PROTOCOL SIGNED IN MINSK ON MAY 31, 2013 BETWEEN ITS PARTIES AND THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN ON APPLICATION OF THE TREATY ON FREE TRADE AREA WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Proceeding from the results of examination of the case and ruled by Article 100(2), Parts 1 and 4, Article 102, of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the RA Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations stipulated by the Protokol signed in Minsk on May 31, 2013 between its Parties and the Republic of Uzbekistan on application of the treaty "On free trade area", are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
- 2. In accordance with Article 102(2) of RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
