DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

THE CASE ON CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE CONVENTION ON THE COUNTERFEITING OF MEDICAL PRODUCTS AND SIMILAR CRIMES INVOLVING THREATS TO PUBLIC HEALTH SIGNED ON 28 OCTOBER 2011 IN MOSCOW WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Proceeding from the results of consideration of the case and ruled by Article 100(2), Article 102, Parts 1 and 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the RA Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

1. The obligations set forth in the Council of Europe Convention on the Counterfeiting of Medical Products and Similar Crimes Involving Threats to Public Health signed on 28 October 2011 in Moscow, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. In accordance with Article 102(2) of RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
