**DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA ON  
THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE  
PROTOCOL ON AMENDING THE AGREEMENT OF 9 OCTOBER 1992 ON  
COOPERATION OF THE CIS MEMBER STATES IN THE FIELD OF GEODESY,  
CARTOGRAPHY, CADASTRE AND LAND REMOTE SENSING SIGNED ON 30 MAY 2012  
IN ASHGABAT WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

Proceeding from the results of consideration of the case and being ruled by Article 100, Point 2, Article 102, Parts 1 and 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63 and 64 of the RA Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

1. Obligations stipulated by the Protocol on “Amending the Agreement of 9 October 1992 on Cooperation of the CIS Member States in the Field of Geodesy, Cartography, Cadastre and Land Remote Sensing” signed on 30 May 2012 in Ashgabat are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Article 102(2) of the RA Constitution this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
