ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY AGREEMENT ON CREATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION VINE AND WINE (OIV) SIGNED BY THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA ON APRIL 3, 2001, IN PARIS, WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Based on the review of the Case and being ruled by Point 2, Article 100, Parts 1 and 4, Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63,64 and 72 of the RA Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations stipulated by the Agreement on Creation of the International Organization Vine and Wine (OIV) signed by the Republic of Armenia on April 3, 2001, in Paris, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
- 2. Pursuant to Part 2, Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
