DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE
FINANCE CONTRACT “YEREVAN SOLID WASTE - PHASE I” SIGNED BETWEEN
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE EURASIAN INVESTMENT BANK ON
OCTOBER 16, 2015 WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

Proceeding from the results of consideration of the case and being ruled by Article 100, Point 1, Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63, 64 and 68 of the RA Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

1. The obligations stipulated in the Finance Contract “Yerevan Solid Waste-Phase I” signed between the Republic of Armenia and the Eurasian Investment Bank on October 16, 2015, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. In accordance with Article 102(2) of the RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
