ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE AMENDED PROTOCOL OF THE MARRAKESH AGREEMENT ON ESTABLISHING WORLD TRADE ORGANIZATION SIGNED ON NOVEMBER 27, 2014 IN GENÈVE WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Proceeding from the results of examination of the case and ruled by Article 100(2), Parts 1 and 4, Article 102, of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the RA Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations stipulated in the Amended Protocol of the Marrakesh Agreement on Establishing World Trade Organization signed on November 27, 2014 in Genève, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
