ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE PROTOCOL ON COOPERATION OF THE MEMBER STATES OF THE COLLECTIVE SECURITY TREATY ORGANIZATION ON COUNTERACTION OF THE CRIMINAL ACTIVITIES IN THE INFORMATION SPHERE SIGNED ON DECEMBER 23, 2014 IN MOSCOW WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Proceeding from the results of consideration of the case and ruled by Article 100, Point 2, Article 102, Parts 1 and 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia(with amendments of 2005), Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the RA Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations stipulated by the Protocol on Cooperation of the Member States of the Collective Security Treaty Organization on Counteraction of the Criminal Activities in the Information Sphere, signed on December 23, 2014 in Moscow, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
- 2. Pursuant to Article 102, Part 2 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia (with amendments of 2005) this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of the announcement.
