ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA ON VISA FREE VISITS OF CITIZENS SIGNED ON 16 NOVEMBER 2016, YEREVAN WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Based on the review of the Case and governed by Point 2 of Article 100 and Parts 1 and 4 of Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia (with Amendments through 2005), Articles 63 and 64 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated by the Agreement between the Government of Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Republic of Moldova on Visa Free Visits of Citizens signed on 16 November 2016, Yerevan are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia (with Amendments through 2005) this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of the announcement.
