DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE
PROTOCOL OF 18 OCTOBER 2011 ON STATE PROCUREMENT RULES AND
PROCEDURES AMONG STATES PARTIES TO THE FREE TRADE ZONE AGREEMENT
SIGNED ON 7 JUNE 2016 IN BISHKEK WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC
OF ARMENIA**

Proceeding from the results of consideration of the case and being ruled by Article 100, Point 2, Article 102, Points 1 and 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia (with amendments from 2005), Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the RA Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

1. The obligations stipulated in the Protocol of 18 October 2011 on State Procurement Rules and Procedures among States Parties to the Free Trade Zone Agreement signed on 7 June 2016 in Bishkek, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. In accordance with Article 102(2) of the RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
