Based on the review of the Case and governed by Point 1 of Article 100, and Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia (with Amendments through 2005), Points 1 and 6 of Article 32, Point 1 of Article 60, Articles 63, 64 and 69 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

- 1. To terminate the proceeding of the case on conformity of Article 1202 of RA Civil Code and Part 4 of Article 56 of the RA Law on the Notary with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia on the basis of the Application of Julietta Yesayan.
- 2. Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia (with Amendments through 2005) this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of the announcement.
