1. The obligations stipulated by the Agreement on the Cooperation of the Member States of the Collective Security Treaty Organization in the Sphere of Ensuring Information Security signed on November 30, 2017 are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.

2. Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
