## IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION TO FACILITATE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FOREIGN ACCOUNT TAX COMPLIANCE ACT (FATCA) SIGNED BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA ON 14 FEBRUARY 2018 WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Proceeding from the results of examination of the case and ruled by articles 168 (para.3) and 170 (para.1 and 4) of the Constitution and articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations stipulated by the Agreement for Cooperation to Facilitate the Implementation of the Foreign Account Tax Compliance Act (FATCA) signed between the Republic of Armenia and the United States of America on 14 February 2018 are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
- 2. Pursuant to article 170 (2) of the Constitution this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of the promulgation.
