ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE SECOND PROTOCOL SIGNED ON NOVEMBER 8, 2018 ON MAKING AMENDMENTS TO THE CHARTER OF THE COLLECTIVE SECURITY TREATY ORGANIZATION OF OCTOBER 7, 2002 WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- **1.** The obligations stipulated by the Second Protocol signed on November 8, 2018 on Making Amendments to the Charter of the Collective Security Treaty Organization of October 7, 2002 are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
- **2.** Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
