**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN  
THE AGREEMENT ON INFORMATION EXCHANGE IN THE FIELD OF  
COMBATING TERRORISM AND OTHER VIOLENT FORMS OF EXTREMISM  
AND THEIR FINANCING IN THE SCOPES OF COMMONWEALTH OF  
INDEPENDENT STATES SIGNED ON 3 NOVEMBER 2017 WITH THE  
CONSTITUTION**

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

1. The obligations stipulated in the Agreement on Information Exchange in the Field of Combating Terrorism and other Violent Forms of Extremism and their Financing in the Scopes of Commonwealth of Independent States signed on 3 November 2017 are in conformity with the Constitution.
2. Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
