ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE AGREEMENT ON THE EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION ON GOODS AND INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION VEHICLES MOVED ACROSS THE CUSTOMS BORDERS OF THE EURASIAN ECONOMIC UNION AND THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA SIGNED IN SAINT PETERSBURG ON JUNE 6, 2019 WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations stipulated in the Agreement on the Exchange of Information on Goods and International Transportation Vehicles moved across the Customs Borders of the Eurasian Economic Union and the People's Republic of China signed in Saint Petersburg on June 6, 2019 are in conformity with the Constitution.
- 2. Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
