DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF  
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE AGREEMENT ON INTERACTION OF THE CIS MEMBER STATES ON PREPAREDNESS IN CASE OF A NUCLEAR ACCIDENT OR A RADIATION EMERGENCY AND PROVISION OF MUTUAL ASSISTANCE IN THE ELIMINATION OF THEIR CONSEQUENCES SIGNED ON NOVEMBER 2, 2018 WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated in the Agreement on Interaction of the CIS Member States on Preparedness in case of A Nuclear Accident or a Radiation Emergency and Provision of Mutual Assistance in the Elimination of their Consequences signed on November 2, 2018 are in conformity with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
