ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE PROTOCOL ON THE PROTECTION OF INDUSTRIAL DESIGNS TO THE EURASIAN PATENT CONVENTION OF 9 SEPTEMBER 1994, SIGNED ON 9 SEPTEMBER 2019 WITH THE CONSTITUTION

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

1. The obligations stipulated in the Protocol on the Protection of Industrial Designs to the Eurasian Patent Convention of 9 September 1994, signed on 9 September 2019 are in conformity with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
