ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE PROTOCOL ON MAKING AMENDMENTS TO THE TREATY OF OCTOBER 10, 2014 ON THE ACCESSION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA TO THE TREATY ON THE EURASIAN ECONOMIC UNION OF MAY 29, 2014 SIGNED IN ST. PETERSBURG ON DECEMBER 20, 2019 WITH THE CONSTITUTION

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

1. The obligations stipulated in the Protocol on Making Amendments to the Treaty of October 10, 2014 on the Accession of the Republic of Armenia to the Treaty on the Eurasian Economic Union of May 29, 2014 signed in St. Petersburg on December 20, 2019 are in conformity with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision is final and enters into force upon its promulgation.
