**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE  
MARRAKESH TREATY TO FACILITATE ACCESS TO PUBLISHED WORKS FOR  
PERSONS WHO ARE BLIND, VISUALLY IMPAIRED OR OTHERWISE PRINT  
DISABLED ADOPTED ON JUNE 27, 2013 WITH THE CONSTITUTION**

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated in the Marrakesh Treaty to Facilitate Access to Published Works for Persons who are Blind, Visually Impaired or Otherwise Print Disabled adopted on June 27, 2013 are in conformity with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision is final and enters into force upon its promulgation.
