ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE CONVENTION OF THE MEMBER STATES OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF INDEPENDENT STATES ON THE TRANSFER OF EXECUTION OF SENTENCES NOT ASSOCIATED WITH DEPRIVATION OF LIBERTY SIGNED IN ASHGABAT ON OCTOBER 11, 2019 WITH THE CONSTITUTION

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations stipulated in the Convention of the Member States of the Commonwealth of Independent States on the Transfer of Execution of Sentences not Associated with Deprivation of Liberty signed in Ashgabat on October 11, 2019 are in conformity with the Constitution.
- **2.** Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
