IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE TREATY ON TRADEMARKS, SERVICE MARKS AND APPELLATION OF ORIGIN OF THE GOODS SIGNED IN MOSCOW ON 3 FEBRUARY 2020 WITH THE CONSTITUTION

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations stipulated in the treaty on Trademarks, Service Marks and Appellation of Origin of the Goods signed in Moscow on 3 February 2020 is in conformity with the Constitution.
- 2. Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision is final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
