IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF KAZAKHSTAN ON TRADE AND ECONOMIC COOPERATION IN THE FIELD OF SUPPLY OF OIL PRODUCTS TO THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA SIGNED ON 16 JULY 2020 WITH THE CONSTITUTION

Based on the review of the case and governed by clause 3 of article 168, parts 1 and 4 of article 170 of the Constitution, articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations stipulated in the Agreement between the Government of Republic of Armenia and the Government of Kazakhstan on Trade and Economic Cooperation in the Field of Supply of Oil Products to the Republic of Armenia signed on 16 July 2020 are in conformity with the Constitution.
- 2. Pursuant to part 2 of article 170 of the Constitution this Decision is final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
