IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE PROTOCOL OF 30 NOVEMBER 2000 ON MAKING AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT ON COOPERATION OF THE CIS PARTICIPANT STATES IN THE FIGHT AGAINST ILLICIT CIRCULATION OF DRUGS, PSYCHOTROPIC SUBSTANCES AND THEIR PRECURSORS SIGNED ON 25 OCTOBER 2019 WITH THE CONSTITUTION

Based on the review of the case and governed by Clause 3 of Article 168, Parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations stipulated in the Protocol of 30 November 2000 on Making Amendments to the Agreement on Cooperation of the CIS Participant States in the Fight against Illicit Circulation of Drugs, Psychotropic Substances and their Precursors signed on 25 October 2019 are in conformity with the Constitution.
- **2.** Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
