ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE PROTOCOL ON MAKING AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT OF 15 APRIL 1994 ABOUT COOPERATION AND MUTUAL ASSISTANCE IN CUSTOMS AFFAIRS SIGNED ON 1 JUNE 2018 WITH THE CONSTITUTION

Based on the review of the case and governed by Clause 3 of Article 168, Parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations stipulated in the Protocol on Making Amendments to the Agreement of 15 April 1994 About Cooperation and Mutual Assistance in Customs Affairs signed on 1 June 2018 are in conformity with the Constitution.
- **2.** Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
