

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE
AGREEMENT ON FINANCIAL COOPERATION OF 2020 BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT
OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL
REPUBLIC OF GERMANY SIGNED IN BERLIN ON 4 OCTOBER 2020 WITH THE
CONSTITUTION**

Based on the review of the case and governed by Clause 3 of Article 168, Parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations prescribed by the Agreement on Financial Cooperation of 2022 between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany signed in Berlin on 4 October 2020 are in accordance with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
