

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE
OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF
THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION ON COOPERATION IN THE FIELD OF
INFORMATION SECURITY SIGNED ON 19 APRIL 2022**

Based on the review of the case and governed by Clause 3 of Article 168, Parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations stipulated in the Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Russian Federation on Cooperation in the Field of Information Security signed on 19 April 2022 are in conformity with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution this Decision is final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
