IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED IN THE AGREEMENT ON TECHNICAL AND ECONOMIC COOPERATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA SIGNED ON 15 NOVEMBER 2021

Based on the review of the case and governed by Clause 3 of Article 168, Parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations stipulated in the Agreement on Technical and Economic Cooperation between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the People's Republic of China signed on 15 November 2021 are in conformity with the Constitution.
- **2.** Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution this Decision is final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
