## IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE AGREEMENT ON COOPERATION OF THE CIS MEMBER STATES FOR PREVENTING AND RESPONDING TO SANITARY-EPIDEMIOLOGICAL EMERGENCIES IN THE PUBLIC HEALTH SECTOR SIGNED IN ASTANA ON OCTOBER 23, 2022

Based on the examination of the case and subject to Article 168(3), Article 170 §§ 1 and 4 of the Constitution, as well as guided by Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations prescribed by the Agreement on Cooperation of the CIS Member States for Preventing and Responding to Sanitary-Epidemiological Emergencies in the Public Health Sector signed in Astana on October 23, 2022, are in conformity with the Constitution.
- **2.** Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution this Decision is final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
