DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF  
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS  
PRESCRIBED BY THE AGREEMENT ON COOPERATION OF THE CIS MEMBER STATES  
FOR PREVENTING AND RESPONDING TO SANITARY-EPIDEMIOLOGICAL  
EMERGENCIES IN THE PUBLIC HEALTH SECTOR SIGNED IN ASTANA ON OCTOBER 23,  
2022**

Based on the examination of the case and subject to Article 168(3), Article 170 §§ 1 and 4 of the Constitution, as well as guided by Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

**1.** The obligations prescribed by the Agreement on Cooperation of the CIS Member States for Preventing and Responding to Sanitary-Epidemiological Emergencies in the Public Health Sector signed in Astana on October 23, 2022, are in conformity with the Constitution.

**2.** Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution this Decision is final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
