ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF ARTICLE 121 § 2 OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL LAW ON THE RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY RAISED BY THE APPLICATION OF AT LEAST ONE FIFTH OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF THE DEPUTIES OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Based on the examination of the case and subject to Article 168(1), Article 169 § 1(2), and Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as guided by Articles 63, 64 and 68 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- **1.** Article 121 § 2 of the Constitutional Law on the Rules of Procedure of the National Assembly complies with the Constitution.
- **2.** Pursuant to Article 170 § 2 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
