DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE OF CONFORMITY OF PART 1 OF ARTICLE 145 OF THE RA
ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE CODE WITH THE CONSTITUTION ON THE BASIS OF
THE APPLICATION OF “RATINA” LLC**

Based on the review of the case and governed by Clause 1 of Article 168, Clause 8 of Part 1 of Article 169, and Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64 and 69 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

1. To declare Part 1 of Article 145 of the Administrative Procedure Code of the Republic of Armenia contradicting Part 1 of is in conformity with Part 1 of Article 61, Part 1 of Article 63 and Article 75 of the Constitution and void, insofar as it does not empower the RA Administrative Court of Appeal to accept the appeal by changing the reasoning part of the judgment and without referring to its final part.

2. Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
