IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF ARTICLE 78, PART 2, AND PART 3, PARAGRAPH 3 OF THE LAW ON LEGAL ACTS OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA ON THE BASIS OF THE APPLICATION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE COURT OF APPEAL OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Based on the review of the Case and being governed by Article 100, Point 1, Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63, 64, 68 and 71 of the RA Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

- 1. To declare Article 78, Part 2 of the RA Law on Legal Acts as contradicting to the requirements of Article 42, Part 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia and void.
- 2. On the basis of this decision, Article 78, Part 3, Paragraph 3 of the RA Law on Legal Acts is in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia in terms of invalidation of Article 78, Part 2 of the RA Law on Legal Acts.
- 3. Pursuant to Article 102, Part 2 of the RA Constitution this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
