

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND GEORGIA ON MUTUAL VISA-FREE TRAVEL FOR CITIZENS OF BOTH COUNTRIES SIGNED ON 12 JANUARY 2023

Based on the examination of the case and subject to Article 168(3), and Article 170 § 1 and 4 of the Constitution, as well as guided by Articles 63 and 64, Article 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

1. The Obligations Prescribed by the Agreement Between the Republic of Armenia and Georgia on Mutual Visa-Free Travel for Citizens of Both Countries Signed on 12 January 2023 is in conformity with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to Article 170 § 2 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
