## IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE PROTOCOL ON MAKING AMENDMENTS TO THE TREATY ON THE EURASIAN ECONOMIC UNION OF 29 MAY 2014 IN TERMS OF PROVIDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE BY THE MEMBER STATES OF THE EURASIAN ECONOMIC UNION IN IMPLEMENTING JOINT COOPERATION PROJECTS IN INDUSTRIAL SECTORS SIGNED IN MOSCOW ON 25 MAY 2023

Based on the examination of the case and subject to Article 168(3), and Article 170 §§ 1 and 4 of the Constitution, as well as guided by Articles 63 and 64, Article 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations prescribed by the Protocol on Making Amendments to the Treaty on the Eurasian Economic Union of 29 May 2014 in Terms of Providing Financial Assistance by the Member States of the Eurasian Economic Union in Implementing Joint Cooperation Projects in Industrial Sectors signed in Moscow on 25 May 2023 comply with the Constitution.
- **2.** Pursuant to Article 170 § 2 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
