DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS
PRESCRIBED BY THE AGREEMENT ON MUTUAL RECOGNITION OF ACADEMIC
DEGREES IN THE EURASIAN ECONOMIC UNION MEMBER STATES SIGNED IN
SOCHI ON 8 JUNE 2023**

Based on the examination of the case and subject to Article 168(3), and Article 170 §§ 1 and 4 of the Constitution, as well as guided by Articles 63 and 64, Article 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS:**

1. The obligations prescribed by the Agreement on Mutual Recognition of Academic Degrees in the Eurasian Economic Union Member States signed in Sochi on 8 June 2023 comply with the Constitution.

2. Pursuant to Article 170 § 2 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
