## IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE LIAISON AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE EUROPEAN UNION AGENCY FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT COOPERATION SIGNED ON 27 JUNE 2023 AND 5 FEBRUARY 2024

Based on the examination of the case and subject to Article 168(3), and Article 170 §§ 1 and 4 of the Constitution, as well as guided by Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations prescribed by the Liaison Agreement between the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Armenia and the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Cooperation signed on 27 June 2023 and 5 February 2024 comply with the Constitution.
- **2.** Pursuant to Article 170 § 2 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
