ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS PRESCRIBED BY RESOLUTION NO. 259 AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 1 OF THE AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING THE EUROPEAN BANK FOR RECONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT TO ENABLE A LIMITED AND INCREMENTAL EXPANSION OF THE GEOGRAPHIC SCOPE OF THE BANK'S OPERATIONS TO SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA AND IRAQ ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE EUROPEAN BANK FOR RECONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT ON MAY 18, 2023

Based on the examination of the case and subject to Article 168(3), and Article 170 §§ 1 and 4 of the Constitution, as well as guided by Articles 63, 64 and 74 of the Constitutional Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court **HOLDS**:

- 1. The obligations prescribed by Resolution No. 259 Amendment to Article 1 of the Agreement Establishing the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development to Enable a Limited and Incremental Expansion of the Geographic Scope of the Bank's Operations to Sub-Saharan Africa and Iraq adopted by the Board of Governors of the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development on May 18, 2023 comply with the Constitution.
- **2.** Pursuant to Article 170 § 2 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and shall enter into force upon its promulgation.
