DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE
OBLIGATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE AGREEMENT ON THE TRAINING OF
PERSONNEL FOR THE CUSTOMS SERVICES OF THE MEMBER STATES OF THE
COMMONWEALTH OF INDEPENDENT STATES IN HIGHER EDUCATION
PROGRAMS AND ADDITIONAL PROFESSIONAL PROGRAMS SIGNED IN THE
CITY OF NIZHNY NOVGOROD ON 27 SEPTEMBER 2024**

Based on the results of an examination of the Case and guided by point 3 of Article 168, parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64, and 74 of the Constitutional Law “On the Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court **DECIDED:**

1. The obligations prescribed by the Agreement on the Training of Personnel for the Customs Services of the Member States of the Commonwealth of Independent States in Higher Education Programs and Additional Professional Programs signed in the city of Nizhny Novgorod on 27 September 2024, comply with the Constitution.

2. According to part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and enter into force upon its promulgation.
