

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE
OBLIGATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC
OF ARMENIA AND THE EUROPEAN UNION ON ESTABLISHING A FRAMEWORK
FOR THE PARTICIPATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA IN EUROPEAN
UNION CRISIS MANAGEMENT OPERATIONS, SIGNED ON 30 JUNE 2025**

Based on the results of an examination of the Case and guided by point 3 of Article 168, parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64, and 74 of the Constitutional Law “On the Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court **DECIDED:**

1. The obligations prescribed by the Agreement between the Republic of Armenia and the European Union on Establishing a Framework for the Participation of the Republic of Armenia in European Union Crisis Management Operations, signed on 30 June 2025, comply with the Constitution.

2. According to part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and enter into force upon its promulgation.
