

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS
PRESCRIBED BY THE NAGOYA PROTOCOL ON ACCESS TO GENETIC
RESOURCES AND THE FAIR AND EQUITABLE SHARING OF BENEFITS ARISING
FROM THEIR UTILIZATION TO THE CONVENTION ON BIOLOGICAL
DIVERSITY**

Based on the results of an examination of the Case and guided by point 3 of Article 168, parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64, and 74 of the Constitutional Law “On the Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court **DECIDED:**

1. The obligations prescribed by the Nagoya Protocol on Access to Genetic Resources and the Fair and Equitable Sharing of Benefits Arising from their Utilization to the Convention on Biological Diversity, comply with the Constitution.

2. According to part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and enter into force from the moment of its promulgation.
