

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE
OBLIGATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE AGREEMENT ON THE ESTABLISHMENT
OF AN INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORT AND TRANSIT CORRIDOR BETWEEN THE
GOVERNMENTS OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN, THE SULTANATE OF
OMAN, THE STATE OF QATAR, TURKMENISTAN AND THE REPUBLIC OF
UZBEKISTAN, AND AS AN INTEGRAL PART THEREOF, THE MEMORANDUM OF
UNDERSTANDING ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AGREEMENT ON THE
ESTABLISHMENT OF AN INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORT AND TRANSIT
CORRIDOR BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF
IRAN, THE SULTANATE OF OMAN, THE STATE OF QATAR, TURKMENISTAN
AND THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN (ASHGABAT AGREEMENT)**

Based on the results of an examination of the Case and guided by point 3 of Article 168, parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64, and 74 of the Constitutional Law “On the Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court **DECIDED:**

1. The obligations prescribed by the Agreement on the Establishment of an International Transport and Transit Corridor between the Governments of the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Sultanate of Oman, the State of Qatar, Turkmenistan and the Republic of Uzbekistan, and as an integral part thereof, the Memorandum of Understanding on the Implementation of the Agreement on the Establishment of an International Transport and Transit Corridor between the Governments of the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Sultanate of Oman, the State of Qatar, Turkmenistan and the Republic of Uzbekistan (Ashgabat Agreement), comply with the Constitution.

2. According to part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and enter into force from the moment of its promulgation.
