

**IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE
OBLIGATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE PROTOCOL SIGNED ON 26 MAY 2025 ON
MAKING AMENDMENTS AND SUPPLEMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT
OF THE FRENCH REPUBLIC ON THE ESTABLISHMENT AND ACTIVITIES OF
THE FRENCH DEVELOPMENT AGENCY IN ARMENIA (AFD) AND THE
INVESTMENT AND PROMOTIONS COMPANY FOR ECONOMIC COOPERATION
(PROPARCO) SIGNED IN YEREVAN ON 28 MAY 2018**

Based on the results of an examination of the Case and guided by point 3 of Article 168, parts 1 and 4 of Article 170 of the Constitution, as well as Articles 63, 64, and 74 of the Constitutional Law “On the Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court **DECIDED:**

1. The obligations prescribed by the Protocol signed on 26 May 2025 on Making Amendments and Supplements to the Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the French Republic on the Establishment and Activities of the French Development Agency in Armenia (AFD) and the Investment and Promotions Company for Economic Cooperation (PROPARCO) signed in Yerevan on 28 May 2018, comply with the Constitution.

2. According to part 2 of Article 170 of the Constitution, this Decision shall be final and enter into force from the moment of its promulgation.
