ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE CONVENTION ON INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN ENDANGERED SPECIES OF WILD FAUNA AND FLORA SIGNED ON 3 MARCH 1973 IN WASHINGTON D.C. AND AMENDED ON 22 JUNE 1979 IN BONN WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Based on the results of hearing and ruled by Point 2, Article 100, Parts 1 and 4, Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63 and 64 of the Law of the Republic of Armenia on “The Constitutional Court”, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **H E L D:**

1. the obligations stipulated by the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora signed on 3 March 1973 in Washington D.C. and amended on 22 June 1979 in Bonn are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
