## ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY BEIJING AMENDMENT TO THE MONTREAL PROTOCOL ON SUBSTANCES THAT DEPLETE THE OZONE LAYER SIGNED ON 3 DECEMBER 1999 WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Considering the results of the examination of the case and guided by Article 100(2), Parts 2 and 4, Article 102 of the Constitution, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the Law on "The Constitutional Court," the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **DECIDES**:

1. The obligations stipulated by Beijing Amendment to the Montreal Protocol on Substances that deplete the ozone layer signed on 3 December 1999 are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.

2. Pursuant to Part 2, Article 102 of the RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the date of publication.
