DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT ON COOPERATION OF THE MEMBER STATES OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF INDEPENDENT STATES IN THE FIGHT AGAINST THE THEFT OF VEHICLES AND IN GUARANTEEING THEIR RETURN SIGNED ON 25 NOVEMBER 2005 IN MOSCOW WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Considering the results of the examination of the case and guided by Articles 100(2), Parts 2 and 4, Article 102 of the Constitution, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the Law on "The Constitutional Court," the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **DECIDES:**

1. The obligations stipulated by the Agreement on Cooperation of the Member States of the Commonwealth of Independent States in the Fight against the Theft of Vehicles and Guaranteeing their Return signed on 25 November 2005 in Moscow are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. Pursuant to Part 2, Article 102 of the RA Constitution this decision is final and enters into force from the date of publication.
