DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF  
THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

**ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE AGREEMENT ON COOPERATION IN COMBATING TERRORISM, ORGANIZED CRIME AND DRUGS, PSYCHOACTIVE DRUGS AND THEIR PRECURSORS TRAFFICKING SIGNED ON 10 DECEMBER 2009 IN YEREVAN BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF LATVIA WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA**

Proceeding from the results of hearing of the case and ruled by Article 100(2), Parts 2 and 4, Article 102 of the Constitution, Articles 63, 64 and 72 of the Law on Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **DECIDES:**

1. The obligations, set forth in the Agreement on Cooperation in Combating Terrorism, Organized Crime and Drugs, Psychoactive Drugs and their Precursors Trafficking, signed on 10 December 2009 between the Government of the Republic of Armenia and the Government of the Republic of Latvia, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.
2. In accordance with Part 2, Article 102 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia this decision is final and enters into force from the moment of announcement.
