## IN THE NAME OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA DECISION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

## ON THE CASE CONCERNING THE DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUE REGARDING THE CONFORMITY OF THE OBLIGATIONS STIPULATED BY THE PROTOCOL ON AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE COLLECTIVE SECURITY TREATY ORGANISATION OF OCTOBER 7, 2002 SIGNED ON DECEMBER 10, 2002 IN MOSCOW WITH THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

Based on the review of the Case and being governed by Article 100, Point 2, Article 102, Parts 1 and 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, Articles 63 and 64 of the RA Law on the Constitutional Court, the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Armenia **HOLDS**:

1. The obligations stipulated by the Protocol on Amending the Charter of the Collective Security Treaty Organisation of October 7, 2002 signed on December 10, 2010 in Moscow, are in conformity with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia.

2. Pursuant to Article 102, Part 2 of the RA Constitution this Decision is final and enters into force from the moment of its announcement.
